

House Bill 5037

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by State Board of Pharmacy.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Board of Pharmacy; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a**
6 **supervising physician dispensing outlet fee of \$300, adopted by the State Board of Pharmacy**
7 **and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
10 **July 1, 2013.**
