SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Psychiatric Security Review Board for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal grant funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by board.

Increases, for biennium beginning July 1, 2011, specified limitation on expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal grant funds, collected or received by Psychiatric Security Review Board.

Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2013] on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Psychiatric Security Review Board; appropriating

3 money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Psychiatric Security Review Board, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,348,448.

7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$103,725 8 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of 9 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and includ-

10 ing federal grant funds received from the Oregon State Police for the gun relief program,

but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or re-11

12ceived by the Psychiatric Security Review Board.

13 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2, chapter 585, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium be-14 15 ginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or 16 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and including federal grant funds received 17 from the Oregon State Police for the gun relief program, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 585, Oregon Laws 2011, collected or received 18 19 by the Psychiatric Security Review Board, is increased by \$41,200.

20SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 2122on its passage.
