SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Public Defense Services Commission for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Public Defense Services Commission; appropriating

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
following purposes:

(1) Appellate Division \$ 15,286,177

(2) Professional services...... \$241,863,137

10 (3) Contract and Business

Services Division...... \$ 3,354,813

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Defense Services Commission for the following purposes:

18 Account...... \$ 2,722,500

19 (2) Contract and Business

Services Division...... \$ 498,435

21 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 22 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 23 July 1, 2013.
