

# House Bill 5049

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits expenditures of lottery funds from Parks and Natural Resources Fund for local grant expenditures by Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board for six-year period beginning July 1, 2013.  
Limits biennial expenditures by board from federal funds.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board; limiting  
3 expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
6 **\$51,488,785 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit**  
7 **for payment of expenses by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board from lottery moneys**  
8 **deposited into the Watershed Conservation Grant Fund from the Parks and Natural Re-**  
9 **sources Fund, for local grant expenditure purposes listed in Article XV, section 4b, of the**  
10 **Oregon Constitution.**

11 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
12 **\$2,460,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for**  
13 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Watershed En-**  
14 **hancement Board.**

15 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
17 **July 1, 2013.**
