

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5051

**Approves new or increased fees adopted by Oregon Board of Accountancy and approved by Oregon Department of Administrative Services.**

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Board of Accountancy and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:**

(1) Municipal auditor roster application fee.....	\$	100
(2) Municipal auditor late fee.....	\$	100
(3) Retired late fee .....	\$	25
(4) Retired renewal fee .....	\$	25
(5) Reinstatement application fee (delinquent fee) .....	\$	150
(6) Late fee active CPA/PA .....	\$	160
(7) Late fee inactive CPA/PA.....	\$	50
(8) Late firm registration.....	\$	175

**SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect takes effect July 1, 2013.**
