

House Concurrent Resolution 20

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH, Senator DEVLIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Honors Alice Richmond for contributions to community.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Whereas Alice Richmond was born in Lyons, France, on May 26, 1930, and moved to New York,
3 New York, in 1949; and

4 Whereas Alice Richmond had an entrepreneurial spirit from a young age and was a shop owner
5 on Madison Avenue in New York as well as a clothing designer for Seventh Avenue, an apparel
6 company; and

7 Whereas Alice Richmond married Robert Richmond, a United States Navy veteran, in 1953, and
8 they moved with their daughters to West Linn, Oregon, in 1958; and

9 Whereas Alice Richmond has lived in West Linn for 55 years and in that span has been an in-
10 tegral part of the community, known for her forward-thinking leadership and problem solving; and

11 Whereas Alice Richmond carried her passion for fashion design from New York to Oregon,
12 worked for Pendleton Woolen Mills from 1959 to 2001 and was instrumental in launching their
13 women's line of clothing; and

14 Whereas Alice Richmond is a living piece of West Linn's centennial history and has been a
15 leader in developing a culture of community for the residents of West Linn; and

16 Whereas Alice Richmond has been politically active in city issues, including working on ini-
17 tiatives for parks, water infrastructure and schools, running for mayor in 2008 and serving on the
18 political action committee board to build a new police building for the West Linn Police Department;
19 and

20 Whereas Alice Richmond is a regular contributor in the *West Linn Tidings*, writing on all
21 manner of issues that affect West Linn, and regularly attends nearly all of the West Linn City
22 Council and West Linn Planning Commission meetings; and

23 Whereas Alice Richmond has taken the initiative to launch or assist in the launch of many of
24 West Linn's most popular community events, including the Central Village Summer Days and the
25 Oktoberfest, has worked to produce the Summer Fun Music Concerts and the annual Fourth of July
26 fireworks in historic Willamette Park and has created the 9/11 Yellow Ribbon Project to honor those
27 who lost their lives on September 11, 2001; and

28 Whereas Alice Richmond is the heart of West Linn and a treasure to the city; now, therefore,

29 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

30 That we, the members of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly, honor Alice Richmond for
31 her innovation, entrepreneurship and the dedication she has shown to the City of West Linn.
