

Senate Bill 422

Sponsored by Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Lane County Sheriff Tom Turner) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes rural fire protection districts and state or local law enforcement agencies to contract for agencies to provide district with special law enforcement services as requested by district.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to contracts between rural fire protection districts and law enforcement agencies.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 478.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "state or local law enforcement agency" means**
6 **the Department of State Police, a county sheriff's department or a city police department.**

7 **(2) In addition to any other power of a rural fire protection district or a state or local**
8 **law enforcement agency, a district and one or more state or local law enforcement agencies**
9 **having jurisdiction within the district may enter into a contract for the agencies to provide**
10 **the district with a special level or type of law enforcement services as requested by the dis-**
11 **trict. In addition to any applicable provisions required under ORS 190.020, a contract de-**
12 **scribed in this section may include, but need not be limited to, provisions establishing the**
13 **level, type and priority of the law enforcement services to be provided and the payment to**
14 **be made for those services and provisions specifying the cross-jurisdictional functions and**
15 **activities designated for performance by the law enforcement agencies that are parties to the**
16 **contract. This section does not limit the inherent authority of a state or local law enforce-**
17 **ment agency to carry out its normal functions, including but not limited to the performance**
18 **of law enforcement services that may benefit a district.**
