## AN ACT

Relating to naturopathic medicine; amending ORS 685.225.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 685.225 is amended to read:

685.225. (1) Upon the complaint of [any] **a** citizen of this state, or upon its own motion, the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine may investigate [any] **an** alleged violation of this chapter.

(2) In [the conduct of] conducting investigations, the board may:

(a) Take evidence;

(b) Take [the] depositions of witnesses, including the person [charged, in the manner provided by law in civil cases] under investigation, in the manner prescribed by law for depositions in civil actions;

(c) Compel the appearance of witnesses, including the person [charged, before the board in person the same as in civil cases] under investigation, in the manner prescribed by law for appearances in civil actions;

(d) Require answers to interrogatories; and

(e) Compel the production of books, papers, accounts, documents [and testimony pertaining] or testimony that pertains to the matter under investigation.

(3) In exercising its authority under subsection (2) of this section, the board or a designee of the board may issue subpoen [over the signature of the board chairperson and the seal of the board in the name of the State of Oregon].
