

# Senate Bill 129

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans' and Military Affairs)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires law enforcement unit to train public safety officers in veterans' issues.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to veterans; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"Law enforcement unit" has the meaning given that term in ORS 181.610.**

6 (b) **"Public safety officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS 181.610.**

7 (2) **A law enforcement unit shall train each public safety officer employed by the law**  
8 **enforcement unit in issues relating to veterans.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
