

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 148

May 13

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 12 and 13 and insert:

2 “(k) A copy of the applicant’s criminal records check.”

3 On page 3, delete lines 3 through 8 and insert:

4 “(6)(a) A chief petitioner shall ensure that a criminal records check is conducted for each ap-  
5 plicant seeking registration under this section to determine whether the applicant has been con-  
6 victed of any of the crimes described in subsection (4)(a) of this section, or was subject to any of  
7 the penalties described in subsection (4)(b) and (c) of this section.

8 “(b) The secretary by rule shall prescribe the scope of the criminal records check to be per-  
9 formed pursuant to this subsection. The applicant’s criminal records check may be conducted by  
10 either the chief petitioner or the applicant.

11 “(c) An applicant seeking registration under this section is required to have only one criminal  
12 records check conducted for each period beginning the day after a biennial general election and  
13 ending on the day of the next biennial general election.”
