SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Permits Director of Oregon Department of Aviation to impose civil penalties for violations of aviation laws, rules or orders.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to the Oregon Department of Aviation; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 837. <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, in addition to any

other penalty provided by law, the Director of the Oregon Department of Aviation may impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$720 for each violation of any provision of this chapter or any rule adopted, or order issued, under this chapter.

- (2) The director may impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$2,500 for violation of ORS 837.080 or any rule adopted, or order issued, under this chapter to enforce ORS 837.080.
- (3) The director shall impose civil penalties under this section in the manner provided in ORS 183.745.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to violations committed on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.

SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
