

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 189

By COMMITTEE ON GENERAL GOVERNMENT, CONSUMER AND SMALL BUSINESS

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 21 through 35 and insert:

2 “(5) If the director finds that a violation of subsection (1)(d), (i), (j) or (k) of this section has  
3 occurred, the director may issue an order under ORS chapter 183 disqualifying, for up to seven years  
4 after the date that the disqualification becomes effective:

5 “(a) The dealer whose license is revoked from:

6 “(A) Obtaining a license as a manufactured structure dealer; or

7 “(B) Working in an administrative or managerial capacity for a manufactured structure dealer.

8 “(b) Any other person whose acts or omissions were material to the events that were the basis  
9 for the violation from working in an administrative or managerial capacity for a manufactured  
10 structure dealer.

11 “(6) If a person who is subject to disqualification or who is disqualified under subsection (5) of  
12 this section elects to pay restitution to a customer whom the director finds suffered harm as a result  
13 of the violation of subsection (1)(d), (i), (j) or (k) of this section, the director may choose not to issue  
14 an order of disqualification to the person or may rescind a previously issued order of disqualifica-  
15 tion.”.
