4	"659.850. (1) As used in this section[,]:
5	"(a) 'Discrimination' means any act that unreasonably differentiates treatment, intended or un-
6	intended, or any act that is fair in form but discriminatory in operation, either of which is based
7	on race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, marital status, age or disability.
8	"(b) 'Discrimination' does not include:
9	"(A) Enforcement of an otherwise valid dress code or policy, as long as the code or policy
10	provides, on a case-by-case basis, for reasonable accommodation of an individual based on the health
11	and safety needs of the individual.
12	"(B) The use of a mascot that represents, or is associated with, a Native American tribe
13	if:
l 4	"(i) An agreement has been entered into by the entity using the mascot and the govern-
15	ing body of the federally recognized Native American tribe in Oregon that is located closest
16	to the entity using the mascot; and
L7	"(ii) The agreement entered into as described in sub-subparagraph (i) of this subpara-
18	graph describes the acceptable uses of the mascot.
19	"(2) A person may not be subjected to discrimination in any public elementary, secondary or
20	community college education program or service, school or interschool activity or in any higher
21	education program or service, school or interschool activity where the program, service, school or
22	activity is financed in whole or in part by moneys appropriated by the Legislative Assembly.
23	"(3) The State Board of Education and the State Board of Higher Education shall establish rules
24	necessary to ensure compliance with subsection (2) of this section in the manner required by ORS
25	chapter 183.
26	"SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
27	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect

on its passage.".
