

# Senate Bill 227

Sponsored by Senator HASS; Representative READ (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on Education Service Districts.  
Sunsets task force on date of convening of 2015 regular session of Legislative Assembly.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to education service districts; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Education Service Districts is established.**

5 **(2) The task force consists of members appointed by the Superintendent of Public In-**  
6 **struction. The superintendent shall appoint members who represent the Office of Regional**  
7 **Educational Services, superintendents of education service districts, superintendents of**  
8 **school districts, teachers employed by education service districts, teachers employed by**  
9 **school districts, staff of education service districts, staff of school districts, boards of di-**  
10 **rectors of education service districts, school district boards and other groups identified by**  
11 **the superintendent.**

12 **(3) The task force shall identify practices for:**

13 **(a) Improving the delivery of educational services through education service districts;**  
14 **and**

15 **(b) Further integrating education service districts in the public school system.**

16 **(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the**  
17 **transaction of business.**

18 **(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting**  
19 **members of the task force.**

20 **(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

21 **(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall**  
22 **make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

23 **(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**  
24 **or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.**

25 **(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

26 **(10) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-**  
27 **lation, to the interim legislative committees on education no later than October 1, 2014.**

28 **(11) The Department of Education shall provide staff support to the task force.**

29 **(12) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for**  
30 **expenses and serve as volunteers of the task force.**

31 **(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**

1 the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating  
2 to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force  
3 consider necessary to perform their duties.

4 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015  
5 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.

6 SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect  
8 on its passage.

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
