SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits public utility from collecting amounts that remain due more than one year after date on which first bill that could have denoted amount was issued.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to amounts owed to a public utility. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 757. 4 5 SECTION 2. If a public utility issues a bill to a customer for an amount that is less than 6 the amount that the customer owes the public utility for the production, transmission, de-7 livery or furnishing of heat, light, water or power, the public utility may collect the re-8 maining amount owed by the customer at any time up to one year after the date on which 9 the first bill that could have denoted the amount was issued. A public utility may not collect 10 any amounts that remain due more than a year after the date on which the first bill that

could have denoted the amount was issued.
