

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 25

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, lines 10 through 12, restore the bracketed material and delete the
2 boldfaced material.

3 After line 16, insert:

4 “(1) ‘Charter boat’ means a boat used to carry seven or more passengers for hire for angling,
5 sightseeing or other recreational purposes.

6 “(2) ‘Charter boat’ does not include a ‘passenger vessel’ or ‘small passenger vessel,’ as defined
7 by the State Marine Board by rule, that:

8 “(a) Has been inspected and documented by the United States Coast Guard;

9 “(b) Carries more than 12 passengers for hire; and

10 “(c) Operates east of the demarcation lines described in the International Collision Regulations
11 at Sea of 1972 on waters identified by the board by rule.”.

12 On page 2, delete lines 2 through 4 and insert:

13 “(2) A person who holds a valid license or registration issued by the State of Washington may
14 engage in the business of carrying passengers for hire for angling, sightseeing or other recreational
15 purposes in this state without obtaining a charter boat license from the board if:”.
