SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Education to conduct study on instruction of talented and gifted children. Requires department to submit report to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2014.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 2 Relating to the instruction of talented and gifted children; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Education shall conduct a study on the instruction of talented and gifted children. The study must include an analysis of:
 - (a) The resources that are needed to provide instruction to talented and gifted children.
 - (b) The appropriate level of funding for the instruction of talented and gifted children, including potential methods for providing funding.
 - (c) The number of children who would benefit from the instruction of talented and gifted children.
 - (2) The department shall submit a report on the study described in subsection (1) of this section to the interim legislative committees on education no later than July 1, 2014.
 - SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
