

# Enrolled Senate Bill 284

CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to infant screening.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "lysosomal storage disorder" means Krabbe disease, Pompe disease, Gaucher disease, Fabry disease, Niemann-Pick disease or any other inherited metabolic disorder resulting from a defect in lysosomal functionality.**

**(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall conduct a study related to infants who have a lysosomal storage disorder and assess the feasibility of requiring infants born in this state to be screened and treated for lysosomal storage disorders. The authority shall report the results of the study to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided for in ORS 192.245, on or before March 1, 2015.**

**SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on March 2, 2015.**
