

Senate Bill 380

Sponsored by Senator BATES (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows owner of motorcycle to use special registration plates.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to special registration plates; amending ORS 805.255, 805.260, 805.263 and 805.266 and section
3 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 805.255 is amended to read:

6 805.255. (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish a salmon registration plate pro-
7 gram to issue special registration plates called "salmon registration plates" upon request to owners
8 of motor vehicles registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)** to observe the impor-
9 tance of salmonid to Oregon. In addition, the department may adopt rules for issuance of salmon
10 registration plates for vehicles not registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)**.

11 (2) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, for each salmon registration plate issued
12 under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall collect a surcharge of \$7.50 for each year
13 of the registration period, payable when the plate is issued and upon each subsequent renewal of
14 registration of a vehicle bearing the plate. The department shall distribute the surcharge as pro-
15 vided in ORS 805.256.

16 **SECTION 2.** ORS 805.260 is amended to read:

17 805.260. (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish a cultural registration plate pro-
18 gram to issue special registration plates called "cultural registration plates" upon request to owners
19 of motor vehicles registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)** to observe the impor-
20 tance of culture to Oregon. In addition, the department may adopt rules for issuance of cultural
21 registration plates for vehicles not registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)**.

22 (2) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, for each cultural registration plate issued
23 under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall collect a surcharge of \$15 payable when
24 the plate is issued and upon each subsequent renewal of registration of a vehicle bearing the plate.
25 The department shall distribute the surcharge as provided in ORS 805.261.

26 (3) The department, in consultation with the Trust for Cultural Development Board, shall design
27 the cultural registration plates. The plates shall meet the requirements for registration plates de-
28 scribed in ORS 803.535.

29 **SECTION 3.** ORS 805.263 is amended to read:

30 805.263. (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish a Crater Lake National Park reg-
31 istration plate program to issue special registration plates called "Crater Lake National Park reg-
32 istration plates" upon request to owners of motor vehicles registered under the provisions of ORS

1 803.420 (1) **or (3)** to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Crater Lake National Park. The de-
2 partment may adopt rules for issuance of Crater Lake National Park registration plates for vehicles
3 that are not registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)**.

4 (2) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, for each Crater Lake National Park regis-
5 tration plate issued under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall collect a surcharge
6 of \$10 payable when the plate is issued. The department shall distribute the surcharge as provided
7 in ORS 805.264.

8 **SECTION 4.** ORS 805.266 is amended to read:

9 805.266. (1) Except as provided in section 3, chapter 709, Oregon Laws 2011, the Department of
10 Transportation shall establish a wine country registration plate program to issue special registration
11 plates called "wine country registration plates" upon request to owners of motor vehicles registered
12 under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)**.

13 (2) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, for each set of wine country registration
14 plates issued under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall collect a surcharge of \$30
15 payable when the plates are issued and upon each subsequent renewal of registration of a vehicle
16 bearing the plates. The department shall transfer the moneys from the surcharge as provided in ORS
17 805.272.

18 **SECTION 5.** Section 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 8, chapter 709,
19 Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read:

20 **Sec. 2.** (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish a Pacific Wonderland registration
21 plate program to issue special registration plates called "Pacific Wonderland registration plates"
22 upon request to owners of motor vehicles registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or**
23 **(3)**. In addition, the department may adopt rules for issuance of Pacific Wonderland registration
24 plates for vehicles not registered under the provisions of ORS 803.420 (1) **or (3)**.

25 (2) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, for each set of Pacific Wonderland registra-
26 tion plates issued under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall collect a surcharge of
27 \$100 payable when the plates are issued. The department shall transfer the moneys from the sur-
28 charge as provided in section 3, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009.

29 (3) Notwithstanding ORS 803.530, Pacific Wonderland registration plates may be transferred
30 from vehicle to vehicle if the department stops issuing the plates, as long as the plates are not so
31 old, damaged, mutilated or otherwise rendered illegible as to be not useful for purposes of identifi-
32 cation.

33 (4) The department shall limit the total number of Pacific Wonderland registration plates to
34 40,000 sets of plates.

35 (5) Notwithstanding ORS 805.202, until the department has issued 40,000 sets of plates under this
36 section, the department may issue five kinds of special registration plates at any one time.
