

# Senate Bill 456

Sponsored by Senator DINGFELDER; Senators EDWARDS, KRUSE, ROSENBAUM, Representatives BENTZ, BOONE, CLEM, HOYLE, KENY-GUYER, MCLANE, OLSON, THOMPSON (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for nutrition program for low-income seniors.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the**  
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$400,000, which may be expended for the purpose of providing**  
7 **fresh Oregon-grown fruits, vegetables and cut herbs from farmers' markets and roadside**  
8 **stands to eligible low-income seniors under the Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
