SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for nutrition program for low-income seniors.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the

6 General Fund, the amount of \$400,000, which may be expended for the purpose of providing

7 fresh Oregon-grown fruits, vegetables and cut herbs from farmers' markets and roadside

8 stands to eligible low-income seniors under the Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
11 on its passage.
