

Senate Bill 457

Sponsored by Senator BATES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to report to Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly on changes necessary to implement federal health care law.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to health care; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall review the state health care laws ad-**
5 **ministered by the authority and shall report to the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly any**
6 **changes to the laws that are necessary to implement the requirements of and the state**
7 **options available under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (P.L. 111-148),**
8 **as amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (P.L. 111-152).**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
