77th OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2013 Regular Session

Senate Bill 472

Sponsored by Senator BURDICK (at the request of Laurie Hausner)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Child Support Program and Division of Child Support of Department of Justice to submit report related to establishment, collection and enforcement of child support obligations from obligors who are sole proprietors, self-employed or independent contractors.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child support enforcement; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> No later than July 1, 2014, the Child Support Program described in ORS

5 180.345 and the Division of Child Support of the Department of Justice shall submit a report

to the interim legislative committees that have authority over the subject area of domestic
 relations and child support. The report must include:

- 8 (1) A summary of the current statutes and rules regarding the establishment, collection 9 and enforcement of child support obligations from obligors who are sole proprietors, self-10 employed or independent contractors; and
- (2) Recommendations for legislative changes that may result in increased and more effi cient establishment, collection and enforcement of child support obligations from obligors
 who are sole proprietors, self-employed or independent contractors.

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 16 on its passage.
