Applies to refunds issued by department on or after January 1, 2014. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to administration of Department of Revenue; and prescribing an effective date. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 305. 4 SECTION 2. Before the Department of Revenue may issue any refund to a taxpayer in 5 excess of \$_____, the taxpayer's return and the amount of the proposed refund shall be 6 personally verified as accurate by at least two employees of the department, including a su-7 pervisory employee at or above the level of executive manager or principal manager, or the 9 equivalent. SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to refunds issued by the Department of 10 Revenue on or after January 1, 2014. 11 SECTION 4. This 2013 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2013 12 regular session of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 13 14
