

Senate Bill 487

Sponsored by Senators HANSELL, THOMSEN, Representative HOYLE; Senator JOHNSON, Representatives CLEM, DOHERTY, HUFFMAN, JOHNSON, SPRENGER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands offense of violation of slow-moving vehicle emblem requirements to include display of slow-moving vehicle emblem on highway for purpose other than what is required under law.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the offense of violation of slow-moving vehicle emblem requirements; creating new pro-
3 visions; and amending ORS 815.115.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 815.115 is amended to read:

6 815.115. (1) A person commits the offense of violation of slow-moving vehicle emblem require-
7 ments if the person:

8 (a) Drives or moves on any highway or owns and causes or knowingly permits to be driven or
9 moved on any highway a vehicle or combination of vehicles if the vehicle or combination of vehicles:

10 [(a)] (A) Is required by ORS 815.110 to be equipped with a slow-moving vehicle emblem and the
11 vehicle is not equipped with an emblem in the manner required by ORS 815.060.

12 [(b)] (B) Is displaying a slow-moving vehicle emblem when not required under ORS 815.110 or
13 in a manner not in conformity with ORS 815.060[.]; **or**

14 (b) **Displays a slow-moving vehicle emblem on a highway when not required under ORS**
15 **815.110.**

16 (2) This section is subject to exemptions from this section established under ORS 815.120.

17 (3) The offense described in this section, violation of slow-moving vehicle emblem requirements,
18 is a Class C traffic violation.

19 **SECTION 2.** **The amendments to ORS 815.115 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to vio-**
20 **lations committed on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**
