Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to apply to United States Secretary of Health and Human Services to participate in wellness program demonstration project.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the promotion of wellness.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services, in consultation with

6 the Oregon Health Authority, shall apply to the United States Secretary of Health and Hu-

man Services to participate in a wellness program demonstration project under 42 U.S.C.
300gg-4(l).

9 (2) The department shall adopt rules establishing requirements for an insurer's imple-10 mentation of a wellness program as part of the demonstration project.

(3) ORS 743.824 applies to any wellness program implemented as part of the demon stration project.

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
