

A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5503

Ordered by the Senate June 11

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by ____.]
[Limits biennial expenditures of ____ from federal funds.]
Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by State Department of Agriculture.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) **Per ton inspection fee
for official inspection
of fertilizer, agricultural
mineral and agricultural
amendment \$ 0.45**
- (2) **Per ton inspection fee for
official inspection of gypsum \$ 0.05**

SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a per acre fee for open field burning of \$20, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) **Global Food Safety
Initiative benchmarked
schemes certification fee \$ 300**
- (2) **Certification and third-party
audit services hourly fee \$ 92**
- (3) **New applicant fee for
USDA National Organic Program**
