## SUMMARY

[Limits biennial expenditures of \_\_\_\_\_ from federal funds.] Increases, for biennium beginning July 1, 2011, specified limitation on expenditures, as further modified, from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Board of **Chiropractic Examiners.** 

Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2013] on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to state financial administration; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
5	expenditures established by section 1, chapter 249, Oregon Laws 2011, as modified by legisla-
6	tive or Emergency Board action, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum
7	limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous
8	Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Board
9	of Chiropractic Examiners, is increased by \$25,743.
10	SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
12	on its passage.

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
