Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$_____ is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for _____ from federal funds collected or received by the ____ SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect July 1, 2013.
