

# Senate Bill 5512

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to \_\_\_\_\_ for biennial expenses.  
Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by \_\_\_\_\_.  
Limits biennial expenditures of \_\_\_\_\_ from federal funds.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to \_\_\_\_\_, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out**  
6 **of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_**  
8 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of**  
9 **expenses for \_\_\_\_\_ from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
10 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the \_\_\_\_\_.**

11 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_**  
12 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
