A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5518

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for certain biennial expenses.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for distribution as grants-in-aid, for program costs and to purchase services.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain federal funds.

Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from certain federal funds received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and

Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits payment by department of expenses related to state education lottery bonds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

18 <u>SECTION 10.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 20 July 1, 2013.

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
