SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for State School Fund. Limits biennial expenditures from lottery moneys allocated from Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to department for State School Fund.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department for State School Fund.

Prohibits, for biennium, specified uses of moneys from State School Fund. Specifies, for 2013 and 2014 fiscal years, total amount that department may spend from State School Fund.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for Local Option Equalization Grants Account.]

Transfers moneys from State School Fund to Local Option Equalization Grants Account. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,235,452,436 for the State School Fund.
 - <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$314,547,564 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
 - <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$400,826 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of Education from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education for the State School Fund.
- SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 327.008 and 327.013, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, the Department of Education:
 - (1) May not expend any moneys from the State School Fund for the administration of ORS 326.133 and 326.136.
 - (2) May expend up to \$968,000 from the State School Fund for the contract described in
