

A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5521

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to department for fire protection expenses.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the State Forestry Department; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

- (1) Agency administration..... \$ 200,000
- (2) Fire protection..... \$ 38,599,721
- (3) Private forests \$ 14,324,295
- (4) Debt service \$ 2,873,589

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for research projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following purposes:

- (1) Agency administration..... \$ 25,707,214
- (2) Fire protection..... \$ 63,321,292
- (3) State forests \$ 89,129,389
- (4) Private forests \$ 9,647,638
- (5) Capital improvement..... \$ 4,314,778
