

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5534

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Oregon Military Department, for the
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
4 following purposes:

- 5 (1) Administration..... \$ 4,436,451
- 6 (2) Operations..... \$ 6,369,813
- 7 (3) Emergency management..... \$ 1,888,413
- 8 (4) Community support \$ 205,681
- 9 (5) Capital debt service and
10 related costs \$ 11,152,208

11 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
12 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limits for payment
13 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-
14 imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds
15 not described in this section, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department, for
16 the following purposes:

- 17 (1) Administration..... \$ 2,187,283
- 18 (2) Operations..... \$ 5,430,904
- 19 (3) Emergency management..... \$ 92,480,445
- 20 (4) Community support \$ 2,068,723
- 21 (5) Capital debt service and
22 related costs \$ 107,355

23 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
24 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limits for payment
25 of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2 of this 2013 Act,
26 collected or received by the Oregon Military Department, for the following purposes:

- 27 (1) Operations..... \$113,016,545
- 28 (2) Emergency management..... \$157,340,047
- 29 (3) Community support \$ 7,939,197
- 30 (4) Capital improvement..... \$ 4,631,304

31 “**SECTION 4.** This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
32 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
33 July 1, 2013.”
