## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Prescribes duties for specified scientific and technical advisory committee and gives committee authority to [select members] nominate candidates for membership. Declares emergency effective on passage

(1) [To aid and advise the Ocean Policy Advisory Council in the performance of its func-5 6 tions, the council] The Ocean Policy Advisory Council shall establish a permanent scientific and technical advisory committee chaired by the director of the Sea Grant College program or other 7 similarly qualified member of the [Ocean Policy Advisory Council and may establish additional com-8 9 mittees as needed.] council. The committee shall: 10 (a) Make recommendations to the council relating to the performance of the council's functions: and 11 12(b) Make recommendations, subject to the availability of funds and time, to state agen-13 cies on matters related to this state's ocean or nearshore resources. (2) The committee shall consist of: 14 (a) Members appointed by the council who are serving on the effective date of this 2013 15 Act. 16 17(b) Such other persons nominated by the committee and appointed by the council according to the procedures described in subsections (3) and (4) of this section. 18 (3) If there is a vacancy on the committee or if the committee determines that a new 19 scientific or technical discipline must be represented on the committee in order for the 2021committee to perform its research duties, the committee shall do all of the following: (a) Solicit the names of candidates for committee membership from the public. 22(b) Evaluate the expertise of the candidates. To be eligible to serve on the committee a 2324 candidate must possess a scientific and technical background in a discipline relevant to the duties specified in ORS 196.443 that is sufficient for the individual to fulfill the duties of a 25member of the committee as specified in subsection (1) of this section and to advise regard-2627ing marine reserves as provided for in ORS 196.545. 28 (c) Evaluate the candidate's availability to serve on the committee and any potential or NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

2 (d) Nominate one or more candidates for committee membership who fulfill the require-3 ments of this subsection.

(e) Submit a list of nominees to the council for consideration.

5 (4) Upon receipt of a list of nominees prepared by the committee under subsection (3) of 6 this section, the council may appoint one or more new committee members selected from the 7 list of nominees. If the council does not select one or more new committee members from 8 the list of nominees, the committee shall prepare a new list in the same manner provided for 9 in subsection (3) of this section until such time as the council appoints one or more new 10 members to the committee.

(5) The council shall adopt rules for the administration of subsection (4) of this section.
[(2)] (6) The council may establish advisory committees in addition to the committee
provided for in subsections (1) to (5) of this section. Members of any advisory committee
established under this section [Members of the advisory committees] are not entitled to compensation, but in the discretion of the council may be reimbursed from funds available to council for
actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official

18 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 20 on its passage.

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
