

# Senate Bill 581

Sponsored by Senators ROBLAN, FERRIOLI, PROZANSKI, KRUSE, JOHNSON, GIROD, Representatives HANNA, MCLANE, BARNHART (at the request of Joint Task Force on County Payments)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset date for provisions of law relating to county in fiscal distress and fiscal assistance board statutes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to counties in fiscal distress; amending sections 5 and 6, chapter 76, Oregon Laws 2012; and  
3 declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 5, chapter 76, Oregon Laws 2012, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 5.** ORS 203.095 and 203.100 **and sections 3 and 4, chapter 76, Oregon Laws 2012**, are  
7 repealed on January 2, [2014] **2016**.

8 **SECTION 2.** Section 6, chapter 76, Oregon Laws 2012, is amended to read:

9 **Sec. 6.** If ORS 203.095 and 203.100 **and sections 3 and 4, chapter 76, Oregon Laws 2012**, are  
10 repealed, any moneys remaining in the Fiscal Distressed Counties Fund on January 2, [2014] **2016**,  
11 shall be returned as prescribed in section 3 (4) [of this 2012 Act], **chapter 76, Oregon Laws 2012**.

12 **SECTION 3.** **This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
13 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
14 **on its passage.**
