## **A-Engrossed** Senate Bill 722

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs Oregon Health Authority [to conduct study assessing activities related to human papillomavirus and] to prepare human papillomavirus and comprehensive related cancer [comprehensive] control plan as addendum to Oregon Comprehensive Cancer Plan.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to the human papillomavirus; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) In an effort to reduce the burden of the human papillomavirus and re-
5	lated cancers in this state, the Oregon Health Authority shall prepare a human
6	papillomavirus and comprehensive related cancer control plan as an addendum to the Oregon
7	Comprehensive Cancer Plan that assesses the following:
8	(a) Existing disease prevention or surveillance policies and programs;
9	(b) Existing disease prevention or surveillance measures;
10	(c) Public and health care provider awareness;
11	(d) Gaps in knowledge related to the human papillomavirus and related cancers; and
12	(e) Opportunities to improve disease prevention and surveillance policies, programs and
13	measures.
14	(2) The plan must address, at a minimum, cervical cancer, anogenital cancer, oral cavity
15	cancer and pharyngeal cancer.
16	(3) The authority shall submit the plan, along with recommendations for legislation, to
17	the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health on or before September
18	1, 2014.
19	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.
20	SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
21	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect

on its passage.
