77th OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2013 Regular Session

Senate Bill 722

Sponsored by Senators STEINER HAYWARD, GIROD, BATES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to conduct study assessing activities related to human papillomavirus and to prepare human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehensive control plan. Sunsets January 2, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the human papillomavirus; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) In an effort to reduce the burden of the human papillomavirus and re-

5 lated cancers in this state, the Oregon Health Authority shall conduct a study assessing the

6 following:

7 (a) Existing disease prevention or surveillance policies and programs;

8 (b) Existing disease prevention or surveillance measures; and

9 (c) Public and health care provider awareness.

10 (2) As a part of the study conducted under subsection (1) of this section, the authority 11 shall:

(a) Identify gaps in knowledge related to the human papillomavirus and related cancers;
and

(b) Prepare a human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehensive control plan for
this state.

(3) The human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehensive control plan must ad dress, at a minimum, cervical cancer, anogenital cancer, oral cavity cancer and pharyngeal
cancer.

19 (4) The authority shall submit the human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehen-

20 sive control plan, along with recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of

21 the Legislative Assembly related to health on or before September 1, 2014.

22 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2015.

23 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate] preservation of the public 24 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 25 on its passage.
