SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Oregon Health Authority to report to Legislative Assembly on cost to coordinated care organization of complying with program requirements.

Sunsets January 1, 2014.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to compliance costs of coordinated care organizations; and declaring an emergency. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall submit a written report to the Leg-5 islative Assembly in the manner described in ORS 192.245 on the cost to a coordinated care 6 organization of complying with each program requirement imposed on a coordinated care 7 organization by the authority by rule or contract terms. 8 (2) The report is due to the Legislative Assembly on the later of: 9 (a) July 31, 2013; or 10 (b) Thirty days after the effective date of this 2013 Act. 11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed January 1, 2014. 12 SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 13 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
