Senate Bill 733

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allows Director of Department of State Lands to approve, on case-by-case basis, off-site compensatory mitigation in certain watersheds in adjacent states.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to compensatory mitigation; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 196.600 to 196.655.
 - SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of State Lands may, on a case-by-case basis, after determining that no practicable compensatory mitigation options exist in this state, approve off-site compensatory mitigation under which the activities are conducted in a watershed in an adjacent state, if the activities are conducted in a watershed that also exists in this state.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to permits first applied for under ORS 196.815 on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act and permits renewed on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
 - SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
