SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Creates offense of equine tripping. Makes violation subject to punishment by maximum of six months' imprisonment, \$2,500 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to equines.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "equine" means any member of the family 4 Equidae. $\mathbf{5}$

(2) A person commits the offense of equine tripping if the person intentionally causes an 6

7 equine to trip or fall, or intentionally ropes or lassos the legs of an equine, for purposes of

8 a rodeo, contest, exhibition, entertainment or sport or as practice for a rodeo, contest, ex-

hibition, entertainment or sport. 9

10 (3) The offense of equine tripping is a Class B misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act applies to conduct occurring on or after the ef-11 fective date of this 2013 Act.
