

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 813

7 “**SECTION 18a.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
8 ation made to the Oregon Military Department by section 1 (3), chapter _____, Oregon
9 Laws 2013 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5534), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, for emergency
10 management is decreased by \$288,418 for the seismic rehabilitation grant program under ORS
11 401.910.

12 “**SECTION 18b.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
13 ation made to the Oregon Military Department by section 1 (5), chapter _____, Oregon
14 Laws 2013 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5534), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, for capital debt
15 service and related costs is decreased by \$3,180,973 for indebtedness incurred under Articles
16 XI-M and XI-N of the Oregon Constitution.

17 “**SECTION 18c.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, from the Ad-
18 ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business Development
19 Department, the amount of \$281,076 for administration of the seismic rehabilitation grant
20 program under ORS 401.910.

21 “**SECTION 18d.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
22 priated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July
23 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,180,972, which may be expended for capital
24 debt service and related costs for indebtedness incurred under Articles XI-M and XI-N of the
25 Oregon Constitution.

26 “**SECTION 18e.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following
27 amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limits for
28 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
29 nomic Development Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following
30 purposes:

- 31 (1) Business, innovation and
- 32 trade - seismic rehabilitation
- 33 grant program..... \$ 160,421
- 34 (2) Shared services - seismic
- 35 rehabilitation grant program.... \$ 120,655

1 **“SECTION 18f.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
2 **\$1,458,768** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for
3 **payment of expenses for seismic rehabilitation grant program from fees, moneys or other**
4 **revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds,**
5 **collected or received by the Oregon Business Development Department.**

6 **“SECTION 18g.** The Oregon Business Development Department may not spend moneys
7 **appropriated, allocated or authorized to be spent by sections 18c, 18d, 18e or 18f of this 2013**
8 **Act before January 1, 2014.”.**
