SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Establishes Agricultural Experiment Station Fermentation Sciences and Value Added Program at Oregon State University.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon University System for operation of program. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to research programs; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Agricultural Experiment Station Fermentation Sciences and Value Added Program is established at Oregon State University for the purpose of providing science-based support and value-added market analysis to Oregon's wine, cheese, microbrew, distilled spirits and artisan bread industries.
 - (2) Oregon State University shall operate the program in collaboration with Umpqua Community College, Chemeketa Community College and any other community college or high school selected by Oregon State University.
 - SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the Oregon University System, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,500,000 to be distributed to Oregon State University for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2013 Act.
 - <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on July 1, 2013.
