

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 82

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 809.265 is amended to read:

3 “809.265. (1) Unless the court finds compelling circumstances not to order suspension of driving
4 privileges, the court in which a person is convicted of an offense described in this subsection shall
5 order suspension of the person’s driving privileges. This subsection applies when a person is con-
6 victed of:

7 “(a) Any offense involving manufacturing, possession or delivery of controlled substances, **ex-**
8 **cept for possession of less than one avoirdupois ounce of marijuana as described in ORS**
9 **475.864 (3).**

10 “(b) Driving while under the influence of intoxicants in violation of ORS 813.010 or of a munic-
11 ipal ordinance if the person was under the influence of an inhalant or a controlled substance.

12 **“(2) The court in which a person is convicted of possession of less than one avoirdupois**
13 **ounce of marijuana, as described in ORS 475.864 (3), may order suspension of the person’s**
14 **driving privileges if the person is under 18 years of age and the court determines that sus-**
15 **pension of the person’s driving privileges is necessary for the safety of the community. The**
16 **court shall indicate the findings supporting the suspension in the judgment.**

17 “[2] (3) Upon receipt of an order under this section, the department shall take action as di-
18 rected under ORS 809.280.”
