

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 82

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “and amending ORS 162.185.” and insert “amending ORS
2 809.265; and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 12 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 809.265 is amended to read:

5 “809.265. (1) Unless the court finds compelling circumstances not to order suspension of driving
6 privileges, the court in which a person is convicted of an offense described in this subsection shall
7 order suspension of the person’s driving privileges. This subsection applies when a person is con-
8 victed of:

9 “(a) Any offense involving manufacturing, possession or delivery of controlled substances, **ex-**
10 **cept for possession of less than one avoirdupois ounce of marijuana as described in ORS**
11 **475.864 (3).**

12 “(b) Driving while under the influence of intoxicants in violation of ORS 813.010 or of a munic-
13 ipal ordinance if the person was under the influence of an inhalant or a controlled substance.

14 “(2) Upon receipt of an order under this section, the department shall take action as directed
15 under ORS 809.280.

16 “**SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 809.265 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to
17 convictions entered on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.

18 “**SECTION 3.** This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
20 on its passage.”.
