SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies statute of limitations applicable to civil actions arising out of commission of certain crimes.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to crime; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 147.065.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 147.065 is amended to read:

5 147.065. Notwithstanding ORS 12.110 the victim of any compensable crime as defined in ORS
6 147.005 or the victim's representative may bring an action at any time within the [*five-year*] **six-year**
7 period after the commission of the compensable crime.

8 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 147.065 by section 1 of this 2013 Act apply to crimes
9 committed on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
