**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Designates second Sunday of each August as Spirit of '45 Day.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to a day of commemoration for the World War II generation.

3       Whereas the people of the State of Oregon honor the nearly 150,000 Oregonians who served in  
4 the armed forces during World War II, remember the 3,758 Oregonians who made the supreme sac-  
5 rifice with their lives and thank the men and women who worked to protect the Pacific shore of  
6 Oregon; and

7       Whereas on August 14, 1945, the people of the United States received word of the end of World  
8 War II and greeted the news of the Allies' noble victory with joyous celebration, humility and spir-  
9 itual reflection; and

10       Whereas the victory marked the culmination of a national effort that defeated the forces of ag-  
11 gression, brought freedom to subjugated nations and ended the horrors of the Holocaust; and

12       Whereas these historic accomplishments were achieved through the collective service and per-  
13 sonal sacrifice of the people of the United States, including both those who served in uniform and  
14 those who supported them on the home front; and

15       Whereas more than 400,000 Americans gave their lives in service to their country during World  
16 War II; and

17       Whereas August 14, 1945, marked not only the end of the war but also the beginning of an un-  
18 precedented era of rebuilding, during which the World War II generation created an array of or-  
19 ganizations that helped to strengthen American democracy by promoting civic engagement,  
20 volunteerism and service to community and country; and

21       Whereas the courage, dedication, self-sacrifice and compassion of the World War II generation  
22 have inspired subsequent generations in the United States Armed Forces, including those currently  
23 in service in Afghanistan and around the world; and

24       Whereas the entire World War II generation, military personnel and civilians alike, has provided  
25 a model of unity and community that serves as a source of inspiration for current and future gen-  
26 erations of Americans to come together to work for the continued betterment of the United States  
27 and the world; now, therefore,

28 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

29       **SECTION 1. The second Sunday in August of each year is designated as Spirit of '45 Day**
