## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 851

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete the comma.
2	In line 3, delete "776.123, 776.126".
3	On page 2, delete lines 26 through 45 and delete pages 3 and 4 and insert:
4	"SECTION 2. Sections 3 and 4 of this 2013 Act are added to and made a part of ORS
5	chapter 776.
6	"SECTION 3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, each licensee under
7	this chapter shall collect a board operations fee from each vessel using the services of a
8	licensee. The purpose of the fee is to allow the Oregon Board of Maritime Pilots to carry
9	out its duties, functions and powers under this chapter. The fee may not exceed the amount
10	described in section 4 of this 2013 Act.
11	"(2) The fee described in subsection (1) of this section shall be collected in the following
12	manner:
13	"(a) For vessels entering or leaving the Columbia River, licensees for the Columbia River
14	bar pilotage ground shall collect the fee from inbound vessels and licensees for the Columbia
15	and Willamette River pilotage ground shall collect the fee from outbound vessels.
16	"(b) For vessels entering or leaving Coos Bay or Yaquina Bay, licensees for the Coos Bay
17	or Yaquina Bay pilotage ground shall collect the fee from inbound and outbound vessels.
18	"(3) The board shall prescribe the procedures for collecting and remitting the fee imposed
19	under this section.
20	"(4) Each quarter the board shall review the amount of the fee. If the board determines
21	that the fee should be adjusted, then the board may adjust the fee subject to:
22	"(a) Prior approval of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services; and
23	"(b) A report to the Emergency Board.
24	"SECTION 4. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, the maximum board operations
25	fee for a vessel is \$100.
26	"(2) The Oregon Board of Maritime Pilots shall adjust the amount of the maximum board
27	operations fee for a vessel each biennium beginning July 1, 2015, by a proportional amount
28	equal to the percentage change in the 24-month period prior to the beginning of the biennium
29	in the Portland-Salem, OR-WA, Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All
30	Items, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of
31	Labor.
32	"SECTION 5. ORS 776.365 is amended to read:
33	"776.365. The Pilot Account is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the

General Fund. All moneys received by the Oregon Board of Maritime Pilots under this chapter shall

be deposited in the account. All moneys in the account are continuously appropriated to the board

and the board may use the moneys only to carry out the duties, functions and powers of the board, for the administration and enforcement of this chapter and for expenses incurred by the Public Utility Commission in its oversight of the board.

"SECTION 6. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect July 1, 2013.".
