5	jobs to the community while serving as the chief executive officer of the Salem Area Chamber of
6	Commerce from 1995 to 2011; and
7	Whereas Michael McLaran led the efforts to build the Salem Convention Center and adjoining
8	hotel and the Salvation Army Ray & Joan Kroc Corps Community Center; and
9	Whereas Michael McLaran was the executive director of the Albany Area Chamber of Com-
10	merce and worked for United Way of Linn County before moving to Salem; and
11	Whereas Michael McLaran was dedicated to strengthening Oregon's education system, estab-
12	lishing an outreach program to bring businesspeople into schools to share information with students,
13	conduct mock interviews and offer internships; and
14	Whereas in 2004 Michael McLaran helped to establish the Ready to Learn Ready to Work Pro-
15	gram in the Salem-Keizer area; and
16	Whereas Michael McLaran had a lifelong passion for baseball, receiving a full baseball schol-
17	arship to the University of Oregon and coaching high school teams; and
18	Whereas Michael McLaran served with the Salem Hospital Foundation board of directors and
19	with the Cascade Pacific Council, Boy Scouts of America; and
20	Whereas Michael McLaran earned numerous awards, including the Russell E. Pettit Memorial
21	Excellence in Leadership Award and the Vern Miller Key Citizen Award; and
22	Whereas Michael McLaran received an honorary doctorate degree from Corban University for
23	his extensive community service and his reputation as a man of high integrity; and
24	Whereas Michael McLaran's faith in God influenced his dedication to family and community,

26	Whereas Michael McLaran has been described as "a giant of our time"; and
