

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2787**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 18 through 21 and insert:

2 “(d) Shows intention to become a citizen or a lawful permanent resident
3 of the United States by submitting to the public university the student at-
4 tends or plans to attend:

5 “(A) A notarized copy of the student’s application to become a citizen of
6 the United States or an official copy of the student’s application to register
7 with a federal immigration program or federal deportation deferral program;
8 and

9 “(B) Evidence that the student has applied for and acquired a federal in-
10 dividual taxpayer identification number or other official federal identifica-
11 tion document.”.

12 On page 2, delete lines 7 through 11 and insert:

13 “(d) For a student who is not already a citizen or lawful permanent resi-
14 dent of the United States, shows intention to become a citizen or a lawful
15 permanent resident of the United States by submitting to the public univer-
16 sity the student attends or plans to attend:

17 “(A) A notarized copy of the student’s application to become a citizen of
18 the United States or an official copy of the student’s application to register
19 with a federal immigration program or federal deportation deferral program;
20 and

21 “(B) Evidence that the student has applied for and acquired a federal in-
22 dividual taxpayer identification number or other official federal identifica-

1 tion document.”.

2 After line 14, insert:

3 “(4) A student who has resided outside of Oregon for more than three
4 years while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States, but who oth-
5 erwise meets the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this section, shall
6 qualify for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees for enrollment in a
7 public university listed in ORS 352.002 without having to reestablish resi-
8 dency in Oregon.

9 “(5) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 may not grant admission
10 status to a student exempted under this section that is greater than the ad-
11 mission status granted to Oregon residents who are citizens or lawful per-
12 manent residents of the United States.

13 “(6) Subsections (1) to (5) of this section apply only to students who are
14 residents of the United States on the effective date of this 2013 Act.”.

15 In line 15, delete “(4)” and insert “(7)”.

16 After line 15, insert:

17 “(8) Not later than July 1 of each year, the Oregon University System
18 shall report to the Legislative Assembly, for the preceding academic year:

19 “(a) The number of students that applied and were accepted into public
20 universities under this section; and

21 “(b) The financial impact of this section on the Oregon University
22 System.”.
